

**SPRING CREEK UTILITY DISTRICT
NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING (JFAC)**


Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that on Wednesday, April 8, 2026 at 6:30 p.m., the Board of Directors ("Board") of the above captioned District will hold a *special* meeting, open to the public, at 2350 Leichester Drive, Spring, Texas 77386, a designated meeting place inside the District.

In addition, some Board members, consultants, and the public may participate by telephone/video conference per Texas Government Code Section 551.027 (**see below and the District's website www.springcreekud.org). The Board may consider and authorize any action related to the following:

 - v) Well and aquifer level assessment;
 - vi) Drought Contingency Plan (DCP) status;
 - b) *Other*:
 - i) Birnham Woods pedestrian bridge and sidewalk extension status;
 - ii) Budgets related to joint facilities;
 - iii) Regional agency coordination;
 - c) *Next joint meeting date (tent. Aug. 31, 2026)*;
- 3) *Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.071, 551.074, et. seq.;
- 4) Reconvening in open session and authorize any action resulting from executive session;
- 5) Discuss pending business/future agendas (*Apr. 7 – Admin. Bldg. Grand Opening/Water Smart; Apr. 20 – Board Mtg.*).
